

Permission to take part in an EKF examination abroad

Dear Dan examinees,

If you want to take a Dan examination abroad, please pay attention to the following points:

- 1. You must have a valid SKI passport (SJV) with a license stamp from the previous two years.
- 2. You must be able to verify your last passed examination (Yellow EKF card / certificate or similar). Please note the requirements of the respective organizers, a copy of the certificate (Menjo) of the last exam is sometimes also required, for example.
- 3. For examinations up to and including the 5th Dan, the registration fee must be paid directly to the organizer, and additionally an administrative fee of 20.00 CHF must be paid to the SKI. (The bank details can be found on the form). The transfer must be made at the same time as the application form is submitted. This fee is only charged for examinations up to the 5th Dan because the SKI offers examinations up to this degree. No fee will be charged for EKF examinations for 6th Dan and above.
- 4. The following information must be provided to the Examination Officer: Place, date, and organizer of the examination. Please do it in time (usually at least 14 days before the closing date of the organizer) and fill in the application form below correctly.
- 5. The candidate is responsible for registration for the examination, timely payment of the registration fee, overnight stay and similar organizational matters.
- 6. The same conditions apply to collective authorizations (e.g., EKF referees' seminar in Brussels / February or international events). In these cases, as well, please inform the Examination Officer (exam@kendo.ch) of all examination dates and respect the deadline set by the respective organizer. After passing the exam, the result will be immediately entered into the EKF member database by the Examination Officer of the respective country.

IMPORTANT: Only complete applications submitted in time can be processed.
